IPCO Flashing Mastic is designed to protect the termination edges, overlaps, patches, and any additional detailing areas. On vertical applications, IPCO Flashing Mastic must be applied both on the bottom and top terminations of IPCO Flashing membrane. IPCO Flashing mastic should not be applied in any area where it will be covered by IPCO Flashing membrane.

5. Installation

IPCO Flashing Mastic is supplied in either a 5 gallon pail or in a 30 oz. caulking tube. If material is applied with a caulking gun, the bead must be struck with a trowel to ensure the mastic is worked into the termination edges. If the material is supplied in a pail, it may be applied either with a trowel or by hand using rubber gloves as a precaution. When applied as a temporary cut-off, trowel the IPCO Flashing Mastic over the membrane with a very thin layer and allow to cure a minimum of 12 hours before placement of additional IPCO Flashing membrane.

On the Bottom edge of any vertical application, IPCO Flashing Mastic mus be applied liberally to these areas. IPCO Flashing Mastic should also be applied around any protrusions, drains, or any area requiring patching or specific detailing.

All IPCO Products must be handled in a safe manner. Some products (some mastics or primers) may contain solvents, and these deserve special attention to safety since their vapors are both flammable and harmful if inhaled. Read the product label and material safety data sheet prior to use.
